

## RISK ASSESSMENT FOR HAMSEY PARISH LITTER PICK – JULY 2020

<u>Risk Identified</u>	<u>Solution</u>	<u>Level</u>
Traffic	Work in groups if possible. One member to stay alert for traffic. No litter picking on main roads, except where there is pavement. All to wear Hi-Viz vests (provided).	Low
Cuts	Wear gloves (provided) and use long reach litter pickers (provided).	Low
Strain	Waste sacks not to be overfilled.	Very Low

### Covid-19 information based on guidance from Keep Britain Tidy

- Individuals currently shielding, in ‘at risk’ groups or displaying symptoms (or in contact with those with symptoms) or have been directly advised to self-isolate should not litter-pick.
- Wear gloves.
- Wash hands before and after at home or nearby w/c facilities.
- Carry hand sanitiser if you have access to some.
- Stay at least two metres from fellow volunteers and members of the public.
- Don’t pick up sharps.
- Litter should be tied up in strong waste sacks.
- If taking a litter-picker home at the end of a clean-up, please sanitise before storing.

Children must be under the close supervision of an accompanying adult at ALL times.

The litter pick over the weekend of 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> July 2020 is under the control of Hamsey Parish Council and volunteers must follow the guidance given and wear the safety clothing provided.
